

Language, Literacy and Numeracy Skills Check

Level 3

It is recommended that you have a pen and paper handy so you can work out some answers before entering them into the test. Please do not use a calculator as this will not give RTO a true indication of your mathematical skills.

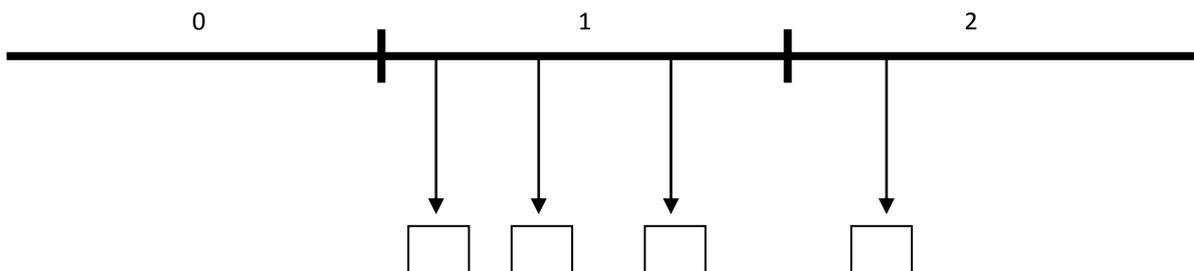
